Project Description:	The applicants are proposing to construct a combined total of six (6) industrial warehouse buildings (a total of approximately 1,574,340 square feet building coverage) on approximately 153.24 acres, with associated site improvements (roads, utilities, parking, stormwater facilities). Access to the sites is proposed at 42 nd Court Street East for Prologis Park and 96 th Avenue East for Bridge Point. A new public roadway will connect the developments east to west. As proposed, environmentally critical area impacts to Wapato and Simons Creeks and associated wetlands and wetland buffers will occur. The developments are not serviced by water or sewer. Sewer and watermain extensions are proposed from the projects sites to connect to existing water and sewer.

SEPA Determination:

The City of Edgewood has determined that this proposal is likely to have a significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is required under RCW 43.21C.030 (2)(c) and will be prepared. Environmental checklists and/or other materials indicating likely environmental impacts are attached to this notice. Additional application materials are available portal.cityofedgewood.org or can be made available upon request.

The lead agency has preliminarily identified the following areas for discussion in the EIS:

- Environment (Earth, Air, Water)
- Plants and Animals
- Energy and Natural Resources
- Historic and Cultural Preservation
- Transportation
- Utilities

The City intends to study three (3) alternatives to be evaluated in the EIS. This includes a no action alternative to be analyzed. The reasonable alternatives analysis shall include other actions that could feasibly attain or approximate the project objectives. Analysis of each reasonable alternative will be done in a manner to allow a comparative evaluation of alternatives to the proposed project.

Scoping:

Agencies, affected tribes, and members of the public are invited to comment on the scope of the EIS. Comments may be made on the alternatives, mitigation measures, probable significant adverse impacts, and permits or other approvals that may be required. You may appeal this determination to the City of Edgewood pursuant to EMC 20.05.250(J) accompanied by a \$1,300 appeal fee. Appeals must be submitted in writing along with the appeal fee via the City's permit portal: portal.cityofedgewood.org. The letter of appeal will not be considered accepted by the City unless the required fee is included. The person appealing will then be notified of a hearing date, and public notice will be provided consistent with the Edgewood Municipal Code. Appeals will be accepted until **November 17, 2021**.
